

Prof. Dr. Niek J de Wit, MD, PhD, FRCPe

Niek de Wit is professor of General Practice and head of department at the Julius Center for Health Sciences and Primary Care of the University Medical Center in Utrecht, the Netherlands. He has been practising in general practice for more than 20 years, combining private practice in a rural area with academic research and medical education.

Since 2009 he is the medical director of the Julius Health Centers, the academic primary care practice of the UMC Utrecht. His research focusses on health care innovation in primary care, with a special interest in gastroenterology, elderly care and oncology.

He is an active member of the Dutch College of General Practice, and contributed to several national and international guidelines. In 2014 he was appointed in the Quality of care Board of the Dutch Ministry of Health, and he currently chairs the 'Overdiagnosis' working group of the Health Council. He is founding member of the European Society for Primary Care Gastroenterology, visiting professor at the University of Durham, UK, and member of the editorial board of Family Practice.
